- Math:** Algebra 1 & 2, Geometry, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, Business Math
- Physical Education:** Karate, High School Fitness
- Science:** Biology, Earth Science, Human Anatomy, Physics, Ecology
- Social Studies:** U.S. History (Parts 1 & 2), Modern History, Government/Econ

ELECTIVES – 4 Credits

- *Fine Arts:** Instrumental Ensemble, Speech-Drama-Art
- Technology:** Computer Skills, Web Design 1 & 2 (includes some computer programming, Introduction to Engineering)
- Other:** Life Skills, Mock Trial, Yearbook, Introduction to Classical Studies (for new students)
